

Warmboard tubing and manifold warranty

Warmboard, Inc. warrants, subject to the conditions and limitations of this Limited Warranty, to the owners of the real property that its products listed below shall be free of defects in material and workmanship when used under normal conditions and installed by licensed professional contractors who purchase and properly install radiant heating systems. Specific warranty durations apply as follows:

Warmboard PEX-AL-PEX tubing

Cross-linked polyethylene-Aluminum tubing installed and used under requirements of ASTM F1281 for a period of 25 years from purchase date.

Warmboard Valves, Manifolds

Warmboard Valves and Plumbing Manifolds, Radiant Heating Manifolds, under normal conditions of use, for a period of 7 years from purchase date.

Warmboard Fittings

Press Fittings and Compression Fittings when used with Warmboard PEX-AL-PEX tubings under requirements of ASTM F1281 for a period of 5 years from purchase date.

Warmboard Actuators

Warmboard Actuators installed under normal conditions for use, and are powered with the correct voltage and amperage, for a period of 2 years from purchase date.

In order for this Limited Warranty to apply, the above referenced products must be installed by a licensed professional meeting all applicable code requirements and good plumbing practices. Failure to install Warmboard products according to the manufacturer's instructions will void all applicable warranties and may result in severe water damage.

This warranty does not apply if the product failure or resulting damage is caused by:

- ▶ Faulty installation;
- ▶ Freezing during or after the installation or inadequate freeze protection;
- ▶ Damage due to tear, breaks, or other external damages before, during or after installation;
- ▶ Components not manufactured or sold by Warmboard;
- ▶ Exposure to temperatures and pressures beyond the specified range for Warmboard products as specified on the product in Warmboard design manuals and installation guides;
- ▶ Any form of corrosion;
- ▶ Exposure to ultraviolet light (30 day max)
- ▶ Damage or wear from abnormal operating conditions, accident, abuse, misuse, or unauthorized alterations or repair or damage attributable to water discharged as part of a system's normal operating process;
- ▶ Exposure to harmful, unauthorized or unanticipated chemicals or substances.



Claims under this Warranty must be made in writing within 30 days after detection of the alleged failure or defect and prior to the expiration of the applicable warranty period to:

Claims should include a description of the product, the failed part, model number (if available), date of purchase and/or date of installation, how the product fails to meet the above warranty and the name, address and telephone number of the person making the claim.

If Warmboard determines that a product identified herein has failed or is defective within the scope of this

limited warranty, Warmboard's liability is limited, in its sole discretion and at its sole option, to either repair or replace the Warmboard product with the same or similar type, size and like quantity or refund the purchase price. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Warranty, if Warmboard determines that any damages to the real property in which the Warmboard products were installed directly resulted from a leak or failure caused by defects in material or workmanship in a Warmboard product covered by this Warranty and occurs within the first ten (10) years after the applicable Commencement Date or during the applicable Limited Warranty period, whichever is shorter, and the claimant took reasonable steps to promptly mitigate (i.e., limit or stop) any damage resulting from such failure, then

Warmboard may at its discretion, reimburse claimant for the reasonable costs of repairing or replacing such damaged real property, including flooring, drywall, painting, and certain other real property damaged by the leak or failure. Warmboard shall not pay for any other additional costs or expenses, including but not limited to, transportation, relocation, labor, repairs or any other work associated with removing and/or returning failed or defective products, installing replacement products, damage to personal property or damage resulting from mold.

Warmboard makes no other warranty, express or implied, except as is set forth above, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Warmboard does not guarantee

or in any way warrant the installation of Warmboard products due to the wide variance in installation practices and other conditions beyond our control. No distributor, dealer or Warmboard representative has the authority to change or modify this Warranty, either orally or in writing, in any respect. In no instance shall Warmboard be responsible for indirect, consequential or incidental damages. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of implied warranties or of incidental or consequential damages, so the limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. In such case, the duration of any implied warranty shall be the same as that of the expressed warranty stated herein.
